Latest News

Welcome to this newsletter giving the latest update on NASH. The data entry period opened on March 14th and there have been over 850 patients entered on to the system so far. Data is entered via our website, and a short "how-to" video is also available there to help get you started.

We run regular data checks and send out missing data reports to sites on a weekly basis (the initial data being submitted by sites is typically missing around 8% of data). Once your site reaches the target of 30 patients, we check the data to ensure it is complete, then send a spreadsheet to you so that you have a copy for yourself. We would like all sites to submit data on 30 patients, but if you are able to add more we are happy to take data on up to a maximum of 50 patients per site.

You will be able to download these yourself from the study website.
